PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of conduct is intended to encourage acceptable participant behaviour at the Heritage Fair so that an atmosphere can be ensured where all individuals feel a sense of respect, safety, and belonging.

Participants are expected to:

- Conduct themselves in a polite, respectful, and cooperative manner at all times during the Fair.
- Respect and accept the authority of student supervisors, volunteers and Heritage Fair Staff.
- Be punctual for set-up at the Fair and be present during all periods of evaluation and exhibition.
- Wear name tags at all times during the Fair.
- Dress in a manner that reflects purpose and propriety.
- Be sensitive, responsible, and respectful of the facility where the Fair is being held.
- Be free of illegal drugs, alcohol, and tobacco (possession, use, or influence) at all times during the Fair
- Accept that the decision of the Fair Organizing Committee, or their representative, is final with regard to being allowed to enter a project, project evaluation, and assignment of awards.
- Leave valuables at home or in the care of a responsible adult.
- **Leave all electronic devices at home, unless specifically needed for your project. Cell phones are to be used for emergencies only.**
